ENROLMENT AT THE LMU

Students with a non-German qualifying degree

Accepted doctoral candidates who have a qualifying degree from outside of Germany, need to enrol at the **International Office**. This is a two-step process:

Step 1:

In this first step, you need to send the required documents to the International Office. Once the International Office has checked your documents, they will send you an admissions letter ("Zulassungsbescheid") from the university.

All required documents are listed on the official website of the International Office (<https://www.lmu.de/en/study/degree-students/applications-for-admission/guidelines-and-faqs/guide-to-applying-for-doctoral-studies/index.html>). **Please check to make sure that you have all documents!**

Step 2:

Once you have received your admissions letter, you can enrol at the university. Please read the admissions letter carefully, as you will have to bring most of your documents (in the original) from Step 1 with you.

Please note: for enrolment, the International Office will only accept **ORIGINAL** documents, no copies (certified or otherwise).
